1. PURPOSE

3. WARRANTIES AND REPRESENTATIONS

No warranties are made or implied that any director, officer, employee, or contractor of LCS is or was authorised to create and / or send this email.

4. DAMAGES ARISING FROM E-MAIL FROM LCS
